# SHOPPING FOR A HOUSE IN BUDAPEST!

The time is drawing very near when we will be able to report HUNGARY HAS TAKEN IN ITS FIRST TRAFFICKED VICTIMS!

After 3 long years of training, structuring, preparing, and spreading the word to others, the team in Budapest is now searching for their first front-line house and day program space! They are looking for a 7 bedroom house in a good neighbourhood: 6 rooms for program participants and 1 room for the live-in house director. Please pray for them in this process as location will be extremely important for security reasons.

Along with searching for the perfect home, they are busy translating all the program materials given to them during their recent internship in Canada and are making crucial contacts with other agencies to receive program referrals. Already an organization in Vienna, Austria has two young women looking for a long-term home and recovery after escaping their traffickers.

The start up date is April 1, 2013. Much is needed: they will need to pay for the rent, damage deposit and utilities. Start up costs include furniture, bedding, pots, pans and everything needed to furnish a house. The classroom needs binders, whiteboards, desks, chairs - the works! As tax season arrives we ask you to prayerfully consider supporting the first SA Foundation recovery house for trafficked women in Hungary!
