STUTTGART, GERMANY

Stuttgart, Germany? A target city for human trafficking? I was surprised and shocked, that hidden from my eyes was a problem that was beyond my imagination and ability alone to do anything about! Young women from around the world, especially from Eastern Europe and Africa, often have little prospect in their homeland. Human traffickers use this to their advantage and entice them with empty promises to come to Western Europe. On the way there, their passport is taken away, they are drugged, beaten, and raped. Immediately we began praying and focusing on what God sees and what His plans for Stuttgart were. During this time of prayer another individual suggested that we check out SA Foundation. So we did! Not only did the SA Foundation have the experience, but they also had the tools to help and a global call to be a part of equipping and helping others to help one girl at a time find true freedom in Christ and to truly have a new life!

As the conversation began, we were able to go visit an SA home in Budapest. I was overwhelmed by what God was doing in this ministry. I was able to see the relationships the girls had individually with each staff member. There was palpable love present! Later we met with all of the staff and were able to see first hand all the teaching resources. They were 'user friendly', very specifically need oriented and came from the years of experience SA has. Everything was well organized, but more than that, this was a team that was equipped, supported with every issue that came up, and confident that they were a part of a much bigger picture. A VICTORY AGAINST LEGALIZATION!!!

The following news release from MP Joy Smith reveals the Canadian government's legislative response to the proposal put forth to legalize all aspects of prostitution in Canada.

June 4, 2014

Dear friends,

Today is an historic day for Canada!

- 1. For the first time in Canada's history, the buying of sexual services will be illegal.
- 2. For the first time, prostituted/trafficked women will not be treated as a nuisance but treated with dignity.
- 3. For the first time, the government of Canada will provide robust funding to help women and youth escape prostitution.

Bill C-36, the Protection of Communities and Exploited Persons Act, was introduced today by Justice Minister Peter MacKay in response to the Supreme Court of Canada's decision in Canada v. Bedford.

We have turned a corner in the fight to end human trafficking and prostitution. We must join together to celebrate this important victory.
